2022 General – Emergency Order

Hillsborough, FL – The Secretary of State issued an [Emergency Order](#) on November 9, 2022 extending the deadline for voters to present evidence of eligibility for [provisional ballots](#) or submit [cure affidavits](#) for Vote By Mail ballots to 5 p.m. Saturday, November 12, 2022.

Hillsborough County voters may submit materials by fax, email or to the two main offices. Branch offices are closed Thursday, November 10 and will reopen Monday, November 14.

Written evidence to support a provisional ballot is only needed if elections staff are unable to verify eligibility and match the signature on the provisional ballot certificate to the signature on file. Voters who are unsure about the status of their Vote By Mail ballot can track their ballot at <https://www.VoteHillsborough.gov/voterlookup>. Voters who cast provisional ballots during in-person voting can check the status of those ballots at <https://www.votehillsborough.gov/About-Voting/Provisional-Ballot-Status>.

The Emergency Order also extends the deadline to report 1st Unofficial Results to noon on Monday, November 14. Updates to the Canvassing Board schedule will be posted at VoteHillsborough.gov.
