These iPads were once used to sign in voters and will now be used to bridge the digital divide so our future voters can improve their reading skills at home.










SPRING INTO ACTION

Select your address and election information for your location will appear. Then choose the Office Holders button to pull up a list of your specific representatives.

Best Practices in Recruiting, Retaining and Training Poll Workers

I'm proud that our office earned honorable mention in the 2020 Election Assistance Commission Clearies awards. The award recognizes our innovations in poll worker recruitment and training.

We streamlined the application process by dividing it up into three steps, which can be completed in under twenty minutes on our website. We also converted all of our in-person training to online modules, and protected the health and safety of thousands of poll workers so they could serve hundreds of thousands of in-person voters in 2020.

Hillsborough County Supervisor of Elections streamlined the poll worker application process, utilized text message and email communication, and converted all poll worker training into online courses.
