Vote By Mail: Due no later than August 23 at 7 p.m.



Visit <u>VoteHillsborough.gov</u>, give us a call or swing by one of my four offices to <u>request a Vote By Mail ballot</u>. Once received, mark your ballot, sign the return envelope and drop it in the mail. We pay the return postage! Or, drop it in a secure ballot intake station at any of my offices or Early Voting sites (when they're open).

Don't forget to seal, sign and date the envelope.

Early Voting: August 8 - 21, 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.



Pick the time and place that works best for you. Vote at any of the 26 Early Voting sites in Hillsborough County anytime during the Early Voting period (even on the weekends!)

Election Day: August 23, 7 a.m. - 7 p.m.



Election Day is your LAST chance to vote. On Election Day, you must vote in your assigned polling place.

Why Are There Republican Candidates On My Nonpartisan Ballot?

If all candidates in a race for a partisan office are of the same party and will be unopposed in the General Election, the race will be on everyone's ballot – regardless of party affiliation. In the upcoming Primary Election, all voters in State Senate District 20 and County Commission District 4 have Universal Primary Contests on their ballot.

- Debit or Credit Card
- Military ID
- Student ID

- Retirement Center ID
- Neighborhood Association ID
- Public Assistance ID
- Veteran Health ID (issued by VA)
- Concealed Weapon License (issued pursuant to s. 790.06)
- Government Employee ID
