

IT'S TIME FOR THE CITY OF TAMPA RUNOFF ELECTION



Early Voting began on April 17th for City of Tampa voters! From now until Sunday, April 23, voters can cast their ballot at any of the seven Early Voting sites between 10 a.m. and 6 p.m.

Visit **VoteHillsborough.gov/EarlyVoting** to find the best location for you. If you prefer to vote on Election Day, head to your assigned polling place on April 25 from 7 a.m. until 7 p.m. Remember, you must be in line to vote by 7 p.m.

Still holding on to your Vote By Mail ballot? You can drop it off at any Early Voting site during Early Voting hours, or bring it to one of my four offices when we're open. *All Vote By Mail ballots must be in one of my offices no later than 7 p.m. on Election Day.*



VOTING IN PERSON? HERE ARE A FEW REMINDERS



- Know Where You Vote On Election Day, you must vote at your assigned polling place. Visit VoteHillsborough.gov/FindMyPrecinct to find yours.
- 2) Bring Valid Identification Please have one or two current forms of identification that include a photo and signature. Find a list of acceptable photo IDs at VoteHillsborough.gov/ElectionDay.
- 3) Use Your Sample Ballot Save time at the polls by bringing your sample ballot with you when you go to vote. Take your time making your voting decisions at home, then when you get to your privacy booth, all that's left to do is transfer your choices from your sample ballot onto your official ballot.
