Hillsborough County, FL - Today was the first day of Early Voting in the 2020 Presidential Preference Primary Election.

As of 6 p.m. tonight, the unofficial turnout to date was:

Early Voting: 2,810 voters

Vote By Mail: 69,048 voters

The busiest Early Voting sites were Bloomingdale Regional Public Library, Jan Kaminis Platt Regional Library and Jimmie B. Keel Regional Library.

Early Voting continues every day through March 15, 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. at 23 sites throughout the county. Only Democrats and Republicans can vote in this election.

Election Day is March 17, 2020.
