2020 Primary Election Registration Deadline

Hillsborough County, FL – Today is an important day in the 2020 election cycle – the deadline to register to vote (if not already registered) or change party affiliation for the 2020 Primary Election. Florida has closed primaries, but there are nonpartisan races on the Primary ballot.

Voters will receive a Democratic ballot, a Republican ballot or a nonpartisan ballot, depending on their party affiliation. All ballots will include nonpartisan races for School Board and Judicial seats, and for Universal Primary Contests in which all candidates are affiliated with the same political party.

This election, there is a countywide Universal Primary Contest for Clerk of the Circuit Court and Comptroller. There is also a Universal Primary Contest for State Representative for voters living in State House District 70.

For those who still need to register to vote or make a party change, here's how to make the deadline:

- Visit one of the four Hillsborough County elections offices by 6 p.m. tonight
- Register/update online at RegisterToVoteFlorida.gov before midnight tonight
- Mail in the registration application or update, postmarked no later than today
