Hillsborough County, FL – To align with Executive Order Number 20-91 issued by Florida Governor Ron DeSantis, which took effect last Friday, the Hillsborough County Supervisor of Elections offices are currently scheduled to remain closed to the public through April 30, 2020.

“We’ve got a terrific remote operation taking place right now,” said Supervisor of Elections Craig Latimer. “My staff, working primarily from home, has been processing voter registration applications and petitions, taking phone calls, answering emails, and holding virtual appointments and meetings to get all of our work done in a timely way.”

During this time, Hillsborough County Supervisor of Elections Craig Latimer is calling on the community to visit [VoteHillsborough.org](http://VoteHillsborough.org) and prepare for the 2020 elections now by:

- registering to vote, if not already registered, or
- confirming voter information is up-to-date, and
- submitting a request for Vote By Mail ballots.
