### 2022 General Election Update – One Week Left to Early Vote

Hillsborough County, FL - After a week of Early Voting, Hillsborough County Supervisor of Elections Craig Latimer wants to remind voters that their time to cast a ballot is running out.

“This is a long ballot with three constitutional amendments, and if voters wait until the last minute to vote we could have lines on Election Day,” said Supervisor Latimer.

Hillsborough County’s unofficial turnout to date, which includes Vote By Mail and in-person Early Voting, is lower than it was at this time in the 2018 midterm General Election. As of Sunday evening, unofficial turnout for the 2022 General Election was 19.69%. In 2018, unofficial turnout at the same point was just over 22%.

“Frankly, I’m a little disappointed with turnout so far, so I am working to make sure voters know about the convenience of Early Voting,” said Supervisor Latimer.

During the Early Voting period, voters can choose the location and day that is best for them. Hillsborough County voters can vote in any of 26 Early Voting sites open 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. every day through Sunday, November 6th. If there are several locations that are convenient to them, they can check the wait times at [VoteHillsborough.gov](http://VoteHillsborough.gov) before choosing where to go. Voters who requested a Vote By Mail ballot can drop their voted mail ballot off at those sites, as well.

“On Election Day, you don’t have a choice anymore,” said Supervisor Latimer. “You must vote near your residence in the polling place assigned to your precinct. And if it’s busy, you have to wait.”

Hillsborough County voters can go to the 2022 General Election page at [VoteHillsborough.gov](http://VoteHillsborough.gov) to look up their sample ballot, make their voting decisions in advance, and consider their options for where and when they can cast their ballot.
