2022 Primary Election – Second Unofficial Results Certified

Hillsborough, FL – The Hillsborough County Canvassing Board certified the Second Unofficial Results for the 2022 Primary after successfully completing a machine recount of the votes cast in the race for County Court Judge Group 14 and the School Board of Hillsborough County Millage Election.

Recount results are posted on the 2022 Primary Election page of the VoteHillsborough.gov website. The results of the recount were as follows:

County Court Judge Group 14

--Melissa Black: 62,386

--Alicia Whiting Bozich: 28,727

--Linette "Starr" Brookins: 58,569

--Mike Isaak: 59,293

Candidates Melissa Black and Mike Isaak will move on to the General Election ballot.

School Board of Hillsborough County Millage Election:

--Yes: 110,486

--No: 111,076

The School Board of Hillsborough County Millage Election did not pass.

The Canvassing Board ordered the recount in accordance with Florida law, which requires that a machine recount be conducted if any race or issue would be defeated by 0.5% or less of the total votes cast for that race or issue.

The Canvassing Board will hold its final meeting for the Primary Election on August 30 at 10 a.m. to certify official results and the post-election audit. The meeting will take place at the Robert L. Gilder Elections Service Center, 2514 N. Falkenburg Rd., Tampa, and is open to the public.

The final official election results will be posted at VoteHillsborough.gov at the conclusion of the August 30 meeting.
