Judicial Candidates Qualified for 2022 Primary Election Ballot

Hillsborough County, FL – Hillsborough County Supervisor of Elections Craig Latimer announces the end of the judicial qualifying period in Hillsborough County. Candidates who have qualified to run for County Court Judge in Hillsborough County can be found on the Local Candidates page of VoteHillsborough.gov. Qualified judicial candidates with opposition will appear on the Primary Election ballot.

Supervisor Latimer wants to remind voters that the 2022 Primary Election will include nonpartisan judicial and school board races that all voters will vote for, regardless of party affiliation. The deadline for voters to register to vote or change their party affiliation for the Primary Election is July 25. Online voter registration is available at VoteHillsborough.gov.

The next candidate qualifying period, which determines all other candidates who will be on the 2022 ballot, takes place from noon on June 13 until noon, June 17. We will begin accepting qualifying documents on May 30, as per F.S. 99.061(8).

Candidates for circuit court judge and federal, state and multicounty offices qualify with the Florida Division of Elections. For information on those candidates, visit the website for the Division of Elections at dos.myflorida.com/elections.
