2023 City of Tampa Municipal Election – Unofficial Results Certified

Tampa, FL – Today, the Hillsborough County Canvassing Board for the City of Tampa Municipal Election met at the Robert L. Gilder Elections Service Center to review Vote By Mail certificate signatures, canvassed Vote By Mail ballots and provisional ballots, and certify unofficial results. It was determined that no recounts are required, and the Canvassing Board will meet Friday, March 10, at 2 p.m. to certify official results in accordance with F.S. 102.112.

Candidates who received a majority of the votes cast will be deemed elected. For races in which no candidate received a majority of the votes, the top two candidates will move on to the City of Tampa Runoff Election. The City of Tampa Runoff Election will include races for City Council Districts 1, 2, 3 and 6.
