Successful Public Test of Election Equipment in Hillsborough County

Hillsborough County, FL – Today, the Hillsborough County Canvassing Board completed a successful public Logic & Accuracy Test for Hillsborough County's 2024 Primary Election.

During the Logic & Accuracy test, stacks of pre-filled ballots were scanned through a random selection of ballot scanners that will be used for Early Voting, Vote By Mail and Election Day voting during the Primary Election. The test confirmed that the scanners are reading every position on the ballot and counting votes accurately. Results of the test are posted on the Public Notices page at VoteHillsborough.gov.

Elections supervisors are required by Florida law to use election equipment that meets the state's stringent certification standards, and to perform this Logic & Accuracy Test under the supervision of the Canvassing Board before every election. Now that the test is complete, the equipment has been sealed and will be kept under camera surveillance until being deployed to voting locations.

After the election, the Canvassing Board will oversee a post-election audit to verify the accuracy of reported results.
