

2021 Legislative Update

New requirements related to voting were enacted by the Florida Legislature this year, including:



Keeping Voter Info Current

- If you need to update your name or political party, that update must be made using a voter registration application.
- If you need to update your address, you can use a voter registration application or you can call or
 email us. To make the update, you'll need to tell us your Florida Driver License number, Florida ID
 number, or the last four digits of your social security number.

For quick updates, we recommend using the online voter registration application on our website.



Vote By Mail Ballots

- If you have a current Vote By Mail request on file, your request is valid through the 2022 elections.
- Instead of remaining in effect through two General Election cycles, Vote By Mail requests will expire after one election cycle.



- Right now, the easiest way to request Vote By Mail is by phone or in person. You'll need to tell us your Florida Driver License number, Florida ID number, or the last four digits of your social security number to make the request. We'll have an updated online request form on our website soon.
- It is illegal to distribute, order, request, collect, deliver, or otherwise physically possess more than two Vote By Mail ballots per election in addition to your own ballot or an immediate family member's ballot.
