City of Tampa Voters: Are you planning to vote by mail?

Make sure your request is in!



If you are planning to vote by mail in the upcoming City of Tampa Municipal Election, make sure to submit a Vote By Mail request as soon as possible.

Due to changes in state law, mail ballot requests now expire after each General Election – so all Vote By Mail requests made before November 8, 2022 have expired. If you want to vote by mail in the upcoming 2023 City of Tampa Municipal Election or in the 2024 elections, you must submit a new request to receive a ballot. We'll start mailing out City of Tampa ballots next month!

If you don't want to vote by mail, you can plan to vote in person during Early Voting or on Election Day. To find dates, times and locations, visit **VoteHillsborough.gov** and look for the **2023 City of Tampa Municipal Election page**.

Florida Supervisors of Elections Scholarship

The Florida Supervisors of Elections (FSE) is offering four \$1,200 scholarships in 2023 for students who have finished two years of undergraduate work and are majoring in specific fields.



Are you a qualified applicant? You must be:

- a registered Florida voter who has lived in the state for at least the preceding two years
- a Political Science, Public Administration, Business Administration, or Journalism/Mass Communication major
- at least a junior in college
- enrolled or accepted as a full-time student in a senior college or university in Florida with at least a "C" average for the previous year

Deadline to register: March 27 (Only registered voters living in the City of Tampa are eligible to vote in this election.)


Early Voting: April 17 - April 23, 10 a.m. - 6 p.m.

Election Day: April 25, 7 a.m. - 7 p.m.
