## PLANT CITY MUNICIPAL ELECTION - REMINDERS FOR ELECTION DAY REPORTING

### VOTING:

- You may not take photographs or videotape inside or into a polling place on Election Day.
- Interviews with voters must be outside the polling place, after voters have voted. Poll workers are not authorized to do interviews. We are happy to arrange interviews with our Supervisor of Elections at our Elections Service Center at 2514 N. Falkenburg Rd. throughout the day.
- All Election Day voting for this election takes place at City Hall, 302 W. Reynolds Street. The polling location opens at 7 a.m. and closes after the last person in line at 7 p.m. has voted.
- Vote By Mail ballots must be received in our office no later than 7 p.m. Election Day. Voters can drop them off at any of our four offices on Tuesday. Mail ballots may NOT be turned in at an Election Day polling place, but voters can have their mail ballot canceled if they want to vote in person instead.

### RESULTS REPORTING:

- We begin reporting results at [VoteHillsborough.gov](http://VoteHillsborough.gov) after the polls close at 7 p.m. No results are reported before that time.
- We will open a media room in our Elections Service Center at 2514 N. Falkenburg Rd. at 6 p.m. and keep it open throughout results reporting. The results presented in the media room are the same results that appear on our website, [VoteHillsborough.gov](http://VoteHillsborough.gov).
- Follow @HillsboroughSOE on Twitter. We tweet updates on the progress of our results reporting during the evening. If there are any technical issues during results reporting, that will also be shared on Twitter.
- Remember that the election results reported on Tuesday are unofficial and will not include provisional ballots. Voters have until 5 p.m. April 6 to submit cure affidavits for signature issues related to Vote By Mail or to provide eligibility information related to their provisional ballot.
